FLYING IN THE SPIRIT THE GLOBAL TOUR THE NEAR-EARTH TOUR 14 August 2011 - 14 Av 5771

Immediately, the Nefilim have been issued orders to make all preparations for the Days of Our Visitation; which has nothing to do with Armageddon, unless we made the proper THINKING changes to effect some real Earth Changes, politically, religiously, morally and economically. All I can tell you is, there are Nefilim from the original Expedition still in the vicinity of Earth, some on the planet illegally, and a hell of a lot more on the way. How long it will take to secure, assemble and pack for shipment, then make the trip here until the Muster is full, is anybody's guess. Just know for a damned fact it's already in operation.

There are only FIVE references to these coming Days of Visitation, and they are attached to this file. I will email them to everybody as soon as we're off the air.

The Akurians are the only hope of staying – or reducing – the Days of Our Visitation, and part of what we're going to do tonight – a world flyby – is to gain what information we can to prepare and make those changes while we still can. Those with a Holy Seal need not concern themselves for their own safety in the Days of Our Visitation, but anybody and everybody WITHOUT one is subject to one hell of a lot of harsh, and mostly fatal, conditions.

You will need both hands free for this Instructional, and Spiritual Hands will work just as well as Physical hands ... and in some cases a whole lot better as we're going to deal almost exclusively with Spiritual Energies and Forces while looking at the Spirit Energy Auras of physical creatures and places.

For those who have been free in the Spirit, even for a second or two, there are hundreds of thousands of words to describe it and none of them accurate in any sequence. Called "in the Spirit" and "up in the Spirit" in the Bible, Astral Projection in Metaphysics, and a dozen other names by the almost-rans of 'transcendental meditation' phony psychic clans, the experience is not only evidence of a soul: it confirms all Holy Law and the Teachings of Righteousness of the Akurians.

For those who can envision, but can't project, this instructional is still going to produce results beyond all we've done before. First, we're not going to go higher than Hathor, the Etheric Plane, and we're only going to tour the Major Cities of Earth. In subsequent sessions we'll flyby the near-Earth objects; an asteroid to two and the Moon. At some point we will do the entire Solar System, asteroid belt, all the planets and all their relative Moons and rings.

Let's begin at the beginning and rehearse making a Body of Light out of a Belly Ball. You're going to travel in it, seeing through its eyes, hear through its ears and feel through its sense of touch. Note, you have just made the required DETERMINATION. Extend both hands, palms facing each other, elbows bent to place your hands at your solar plexus. Let them warm up with your own energy ... send the Belly Ball out from you about three feet, and charge it:

On my command: AKASHA, AIR, FIRE, WATER, EARTH!

Akurians, prepare to fly!

Now it's a ball of your own spirit energy, turned into a Force – which is directed energy – and ready to tell you whatever it experiences. **DO NOT TELL IT WHAT TO SEE, HEAR OR FEEL**; only where

to go during this Major Cities of Earth Excursion. Send your Belly Ball: Etheric Plane, where it already exists, 2,500 feet maximum altitude. You can link up if you wish, or just discern the Akurians in your presence. Everybody at 2,500 feet for the initial approach.

First on our list: Washington, D.C.;

The Capitol Building – to the East are the parking lots and to the West is the Capitol Reflecting Pool. About 1.4 miles West is the Washington Monument, one of our designated Center Points for depositing charged Belly Balls.

Now, go up to 15 miles altitude, or about 80,000 feet. From here just READ THE ENERGY of the city at large. There are dozens of dog-towns that make up the Washington metropolitan complex, and they all add their respective energies and forces to the cess pool it is. From Silver Spring, Maryland on the North to Alexandria, Virginia on the South, Fairfax, Virginia on the West and Annapolis, Maryland on the East.

Everybody read it and test what I read against what you read:

It is one HUGE immoral cess pool.

There are spots here and there that seem a bit normal, and if you note them, they are mostly graveyards; since Arlington is in Virginia – as is the Pentagon – the overall energy/force read seems a bit hallowed, and Arlington is, the rest of it isn't. It's putrid.

Back to 2,500 feet – next stop, Mexico City, Mexico. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

Everybody read it and test what I read against what you read:

It is one HUGE mess of abject ignorance – and murder for the sake of murder. Totally morally bereft as a general energy ... yet the people think themselves to have a very high degree of honor.

Virtually all South America reads about the same way, the highlands with a bit more Spiritual Culture, but the cities are virtual high-tech pockets of dope and murderous scum.

2,500 feet – north-eastward, London, England. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

Everybody read it.

All I read is a lot of Pomp and Poverty ... hatred built on the failure of multi-culturalism. Mostly directed toward Muslims, especially Black Muslims, with Arabs and Indians not very much higher in esteem.

2,500 feet – Berlin, Germany. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet. Read it, let's see if we're seeing the same thing ...

I read a lot of anger, mostly at government – nothing new there, we can find THAT all over the planet! But this is a seething anger. The German people don't feel as if they have anything to say about their Country or their Destiny ... just like when the Kak-Jews ran everything before, during and after World War I ... then came the Nazi/Hitler disaster ...

Everybody, throw a good Akurian Energy Blessing on the whole nation – we've got to let them know they are right about their opinions, but wrong about there not being any other solution than more socialism ... Let's try this one ...

"The Akurians are the answer, search for us, we're here on the Earth and in the Heavens! The ANOINTED, The ELECT, and The DAMNED!"

2,500 feet – Jerusalem, Israel. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

This one should be a mind-blower.

It isn't. It's a greedy, self-centered, mind-set of handout-entitlement mentality. Everybody, Arab, Christian, Jew and intruder alike have the opinion THEY are the sole and exclusive solution: when they are granted all power and prosperity, everything will be right with the entire planet.

Everybody, up to 300 miles, and read the whole area, Amman, Jordan; Damascus, Syria; Cairo, Egypt. I read that place ready to explode for the sake of explosion. It reads to me as if the whole damned area wants to blow up just for the American money it will bring in! Especially the politicians ...

2,500 feet – New Delhi, India. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

What are we reading ...??

Concealed violence, like a volcano ready to erupt. Damned near like the Middle East around Jerusalem, except this seems more like a mass-employment issue with every socialist in sight stirring the pot.

2,500 feet – Beijing, China. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

Anybody got a read other than massive hunger ... ???

Lots of capitalism on the minds of the high-brows, not like its supposed to be in the Great Socialist Society! Wholesale murder a daily event. Treason on every corner. Treason against communism by the powerful; treason against communism by the underground who want to rid themselves of it. The strongest energy here is the force of treason ... 2,500 feet – Hong Kong, China. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

Let's see what the read is ...

Looks about the same to me, except the Bankers and Industrialists want more room to do business that communism isn't going to give them. The general population are all at starvation levels, and far better off than those on the mainland. Not a place I'd want to live, even if I could afford to!

2,500 feet – Tokyo, Japan. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

Pay attention to this one ... there's still hell on the horizon ...

I'm reading as much disgust as I am terror. Everybody knows they're being lied to and lied about, and that is NOT the Japanese standard of honesty or integrity. That's a bubble that going to bust when least expected unless somebody gets their socialist head out of their socialist ass, and damned soon!

2,500 feet – Manila, Philippines. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

Let's see what this one looks like ...

Everything here seems to come hard, harder than necessary. Deliberate deprivation more than lack of anything. There's hell to pay in this neck of the woods, and just about any incident, created or natural, will set it off. It will be a great publicity diversion for the socialists when the time comes.

2,500 feet – Canberra, Australia. Now up to 15 miles, 80,000 feet.

Let's see if there's really anything different here ...

I've never seen anyplace as deceitful as Canberra, Australia! This place has more slugs than a bait shop. It's as if everybody knows everything is jackass, but hasn't a clue what to do about it. Mental mind-set of ''every man for himself'' as long as you take me along ...

That's about all I can take for one night. The whole world is in dire need a cleaning, and they're about to get it!

Isaiah 10:1 Woe unto them that decree unrighteous decrees, and that write grievousness which they have prescribed;

Isaiah 10:2 To turn aside the needy from judgment, and to take away the right from the poor of my people, that widows may be their prey, and that they may rob the fatherless!

Isaiah 10:3 And what will ye do in the **Day of Visitation**, and in the desolation which shall come from far? to whom will ye flee for help? and where will ye leave your glory?

Isaiah 10:4 Without me they shall bow down under the prisoners, and they shall fall under the slain. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still.

Isaiah 10:5 O Assyrian, the rod of mine anger, and the staff in their hand is mine indignation.

Isaiah 10:6 I will send him against an hypocritical nation, and against the people of my wrath will I give him a charge, to take the spoil, and to take the prey, and to tread them down like the mire of the streets. **Isaiah 10:7** Howbeit he meaneth not so, neither doth his heart think so; but it is in his heart to destroy and cut off nations not a few.

Isaiah 10:8 For he saith, Are not my princes altogether kings?

Isaiah 10:9 Is not Calno as Carchemish? is not Hamath as Arpad? is not Samaria as Damascus? **Isaiah 10:10** As my hand hath found the kingdoms of the idols, and whose graven images did excel them of Jerusalem and of Samaria;

Isaiah 10:11 Shall I not, as I have done unto Samaria and her idols, so do to Jerusalem and her idols? **Isaiah 10:12** Wherefore it shall come to pass, that when the Lord hath performed his whole work upon mount Zion and on Jerusalem, I will punish the fruit of the stout heart of the king of Assyria, and the glory of his high looks.

Isaiah 10:13 For he saith, By the strength of my hand I have done it, and by my wisdom; for I am prudent: and I have removed the bounds of the people, and have robbed their treasures, and I have put down the inhabitants like a valiant man:

Isaiah 10:14 And my hand hath found as a nest the riches of the people: and as one gathereth eggs that are left, have I gathered all the earth; and there was none that moved the wing, or opened the mouth, or peeped.

Isaiah 10:15 Shall the axe boast itself against him that heweth therewith? or shall the saw magnify itself against him that shaketh it? as if the rod should shake itself against them that lift it up, or as if the staff should lift up itself, as if it were no wood.

Isaiah 10:16 Therefore shall the Lord, **The Lord of Hosts**, send among his fat ones leanness; and under his glory he shall kindle a burning like the burning of a fire.

Isaiah 10:17 And the Light of Israel shall be for a fire, and his Holy One for a flame: and it shall burn and devour his thorns and his briers in one day;

Isaiah 10:18 And shall consume the glory of his forest, and of his fruitful field, both soul and body: and they shall be as when a standard bearer fainteth.

Isaiah 10:19 And the rest of the trees of his forest shall be few, that a child may write them.

Isaiah 10:20 And it shall come to pass in **That Day**, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, in truth.

Isaiah 10:21 The remnant shall return, even the remnant of Jacob, unto the mighty God.

Isaiah 10:22 For though thy people Israel be as the sand of the sea, yet a remnant of them shall return: the consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness.

Isaiah 10:23 For **The Lord God of Hosts** shall make a consumption, even determined, in the midst of all the land.

Isaiah 10:24 Therefore thus saith **The Lord God of Hosts**, O my people that dwellest in Zion, be not afraid of the Assyrian: he shall smite thee with a rod, and shall lift up his staff against thee, after the manner of Egypt.

Isaiah 10:25 For yet a very little while, and the indignation shall cease, and mine anger in their destruction.

Isaiah 10:26 And **The Lord of Hosts** shall stir up a scourge for him according to the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb: and as his rod was upon the sea, so shall he lift it up after the manner of Egypt.

Isaiah 10:27 And it shall come to pass in That Day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy

shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.

Isaiah 10:28 He is come to Aiath, he is passed to Migron; at Michmash he hath laid up his carriages: **Isaiah 10:29** They are gone over the passage: they have taken up their lodging at Geba; Ramah is afraid;

Gibeah of Saul is fled.

Isaiah 10:30 Lift up thy voice, O daughter of Gallim: cause it to be heard unto Laish, O poor Anathoth. **Isaiah 10:31** Madmenah is removed; the inhabitants of Gebim gather themselves to flee.

Isaiah 10:32 As yet shall he remain at Nob **That Day:** he shall shake his hand against the mount of the daughter of Zion, the hill of Jerusalem.

Isaiah 10:33 Behold, the Lord, **The Lord of Hosts**, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature shall be hewn down, and the haughty shall be humbled.

Isaiah 10:34 And he shall cut down the thickets of the forest with iron, and Lebanon shall fall by a mighty one.

Hosea 9:1 Rejoice not, O Israel, for joy, as other people: for thou hast gone a whoring from thy God, thou hast loved a reward upon every cornfloor.

Hosea 9:2 The floor and the winepress shall not feed them, and the new wine shall fail in her.

Hosea 9:3 They shall not dwell in the Lord's land; but Ephraim shall return to Egypt, and they shall eat unclean things in Assyria.

Hosea 9:4 They shall not offer wine offerings to the Lord, neither shall they be pleasing unto him: their sacrifices shall be unto them as the bread of mourners; all that eat thereof shall be polluted: for their bread for their soul shall not come into the house of the Lord.

Hosea 9:5 What will ye do in the solemn day, and in the day of the feast of the Lord?

Hosea 9:6 For, lo, they are gone because of destruction: Egypt shall gather them up, Memphis shall bury them: the pleasant places for their silver, nettles shall possess them: thorns shall be in their tabernacles.

Hosea 9:7 The **Days of Visitation** are come, the days of recompence are come; Israel shall know it: the prophet is a fool, the spiritual man is mad, for the multitude of thine iniquity, and the great hatred.

Hosea 9:8 The watchman of Ephraim was with my God: but the prophet is a snare of a fowler in all his ways, and hatred in the house of his God.

Hosea 9:9 They have deeply corrupted themselves, as in the days of Gibeah: therefore he will remember their iniquity, he will visit their sins.

Hosea 9:10 I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the firstripe in the fig tree at her first time: but they went to Baalpeor, and separated themselves unto that shame; and their abominations were according as they loved.

Hosea 9:11 As for Ephraim, their glory shall fly away like a bird, from the birth, and from the womb, and from the conception.

Hosea 9:12 Though they bring up their children, yet will I bereave them, that there shall not be a man left: yea, woe also to them when I depart from them!

Hosea 9:13 Ephraim, as I saw Tyrus, is planted in a pleasant place: but Ephraim shall bring forth his children to the murderer.

Hosea 9:14 Give them, O Lord: what wilt thou give? give them a miscarrying womb and dry breasts.

Hosea 9:15 All their wickedness is in Gilgal: for there I hated them: for the wickedness of their doings I will drive them out of mine house, I will love them no more: all their princes are revolters.

Hosea 9:16 Ephraim is smitten, their root is dried up, they shall bear no fruit: yea, though they bring forth, yet will I slay even the beloved fruit of their womb.

Hosea 9:17 My God will cast them away, because they did not hearken unto him: and they shall be wanderers among the nations.

Jeremiah 46:1 The word of the Lord which came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Gentiles; Jeremiah 46:2 Against Egypt, against the army of Pharaohnecho king of Egypt, which was by the river Euphrates in Carchemish, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon smote in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah.

Jeremiah 46:3 Order ye the buckler and shield, and draw near to battle.

Jeremiah 46:4 Harness the horses; and get up, ye horsemen, and stand forth with your helmets; furbish the spears, and put on the brigandines.

Jeremiah 46:5 Wherefore have I seen them dismayed and turned away back? and their mighty ones are beaten down, and are fled apace, and look not back: for fear was round about, saith the Lord. Jeremiah 46:6 Let not the swift flee away, nor the mighty man escape; they shall stumble, and fall toward the north by the river Euphrates.

Jeremiah 46:7 Who is this that cometh up as a flood, whose waters are moved as the rivers? Jeremiah 46:8 Egypt riseth up like a flood, and his waters are moved like the rivers; and he saith, I will go up, and will cover the earth; I will destroy the city and the inhabitants thereof.

Jeremiah 46:9 Come up, ye horses; and rage, ye chariots; and let the mighty men come forth; the Ethiopians and the Libyans, that handle the shield; and the Lydians, that handle and bend the bow.

Jeremiah 46:10 For this is The Day of The Lord God of Hosts, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries: and the sword shall devour, and it shall be satiate and made drunk with their blood: for the Lord God of Hosts hath a sacrifice in the north country by the river Euphrates. Jeremiah 46:11 Go up into Gilead, and take balm, O virgin, the daughter of Egypt: in vain shalt thou use many medicines; for thou shalt not be cured.

Jeremiah 46:12 The nations have heard of thy shame, and thy cry hath filled the land: for the mighty man hath stumbled against the mighty, and they are fallen both together.

Jeremiah 46:13 The word that the Lord spake to **Jeremiah** the prophet, how Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon should come and smite the land of Egypt.

Jeremiah 46:14 Declare ye in Egypt, and publish in Migdol, and publish in Noph and in Tahpanhes: say ye, Stand fast, and prepare thee; for the sword shall devour round about thee.

Jeremiah 46:15 Why are thy valiant men swept away? they stood not, because the Lord did drive them. Jeremiah 46:16 He made many to fall, yea, one fell upon another: and they said, Arise, and let us go again to our own people, and to the land of our nativity, from the oppressing sword.

Jeremiah 46:17 They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt is but a noise; he hath passed the time appointed.

Jeremiah 46:18 As I live, saith the King, whose name is **The Lord of Hosts**, Surely as Tabor is among the mountains, and as Carmel by the sea, so shall he come.

Jeremiah 46:19 O thou daughter dwelling in Egypt, furnish thyself to go into captivity: for Noph shall be waste and desolate without an inhabitant.

Jeremiah 46:20 Egypt is like a very fair heifer, but destruction cometh; it cometh out of the north.

Jeremiah 46:21 Also her hired men are in the midst of her like fatted bullocks; for they also are turned back, and are fled away together: they did not stand, because the **Day** of their calamity was come upon them, and the time of their **Visitation**.

Jeremiah 46:22 The voice thereof shall go like a serpent; for they shall march with an army, and come against her with axes, as hewers of wood.

Jeremiah 46:23 They shall cut down her forest, saith the Lord, though it cannot be searched; because they are more than the grasshoppers, and are innumerable.

Jeremiah 46:24 The daughter of Egypt shall be confounded; she shall be delivered into the hand of the people of the north.

Jeremiah 46:25 The Lord of Hosts, the God of Israel, saith; Behold, I will punish the multitude of No, and Pharaoh, and Egypt, with their gods, and their kings; even Pharaoh, and all them that trust in him: Jeremiah 46:26 And I will deliver them into the hand of those that seek their lives, and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of his servants: and afterward it shall be inhabited, as in the days of old, saith the Lord.

Jeremiah 46:27 But fear not thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make him afraid.

Jeremiah 46:28 Fear thou not, O Jacob my servant, saith the Lord: for I am with thee; for I will make a full end of all the nations whither I have driven thee: but I will not make a full end of thee, but correct thee in measure; yet will I not leave thee wholly unpunished.

Jeremiah 50:21 Go up against the land of Merathaim, even against it, and against the inhabitants of Pekod: waste and utterly destroy after them, saith the Lord, and do according to all that I have commanded thee.

Jeremiah 50:22 A sound of battle is in the land, and of great destruction.

Jeremiah 50:23 How is the hammer of the whole earth cut as under and broken! how is Babylon become a desolation among the nations!

Jeremiah 50:24 I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the Lord.

Jeremiah 50:25 The Lord hath opened his armoury, and hath brought forth the weapons of his indignation: for this is the work of **The Lord God of Hosts** in the land of the Chaldeans.

Jeremiah 50:26 Come against her from the utmost border, open her storehouses: cast her up as heaps, and destroy her utterly: let nothing of her be left.

Jeremiah 50:27 Slay all her bullocks; let them go down to the slaughter: woe unto them! for their Day is come, the time of their Visitation.

Jeremiah 50:28 The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in Zion the vengeance of the Lord our God, the vengeance of his temple.

Jeremiah 50:29 Call together the archers against Babylon: all ye that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: recompense her according to her work; according to all that she hath done, do unto her: for she hath been proud against the Lord, against the Holy One of Israel.

Jeremiah 50:30 Therefore shall her young men fall in the streets, and all her men of war shall be cut off in **That Day**, saith the Lord.

Jeremiah 50:31 Behold, I am against thee, O thou most proud, saith The Lord God of Hosts: for thy Day is come, the time that I will visit thee.

Jeremiah 50:32 And the most proud shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him.

Jeremiah 50:33 Thus saith **The Lord of Host**s; The children of Israel and the children of Judah were oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

Jeremiah 50:34 Their Redeemer is strong; The Lord of Hosts is his name: he shall throughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

Jeremiah 50:35 A sword is upon the Chaldeans, saith the Lord, and upon the inhabitants of Babylon, and upon her princes, and upon her wise men.

Jeremiah 50:36 A sword is upon the liars; and they shall dote: a sword is upon her mighty men; and they shall be dismayed.

Jeremiah 50:37 A sword is upon their horses, and upon their chariots, and upon all the mingled people that are in the midst of her; and they shall become as women: a sword is upon her treasures; and they shall be robbed.

Jeremiah 50:38 A drought is upon her waters; and they shall be dried up: for it is the land of graven images, and they are mad upon their idols.

Jeremiah 50:39 Therefore the wild beasts of the desert with the wild beasts of the islands shall dwell there, and the owls shall dwell therein: and it shall be no more inhabited for ever; neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation.

Jeremiah 50:40 As God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah and the neighbour cities thereof, saith the Lord; so shall no man abide there, neither shall any son of man dwell therein.

Jeremiah 50:41 Behold, a people shall come from the north, and a great nation, and many kings shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.

Jeremiah 50:42 They shall hold the bow and the lance: they are cruel, and will not shew mercy: their voice shall roar like the sea, and they shall ride upon horses, every one put in array, like a man to the battle, against thee, O daughter of Babylon.

Jeremiah 50:43 The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: anguish took hold of him, and pangs as of a woman in travail.

Jeremiah 50:44 Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the swelling of Jordan unto the habitation of the strong: but I will make them suddenly run away from her: and who is a chosen man, that I may appoint over her? for who is like me? and who will appoint me the time? and who is that shepherd that will stand before me?

Jeremiah 50:45 Therefore hear ye the counsel of the Lord, that he hath taken against Babylon; and his purposes, that he hath purposed against the land of the Chaldeans: Surely the least of the flock shall draw them out: surely he shall make their habitation desolate with them.

Jeremiah 50:46 At the noise of the taking of Babylon the earth is moved, and the cry is heard among the nations.

Micah 7:1 Woe is me! for I am as when they have gathered the summer fruits, as the grapegleanings of the vintage: there is no cluster to eat: my soul desired the firstripe fruit.

Micah 7:2 The good man is perished out of the earth: and there is none upright among men: they all lie in wait for blood; they hunt every man his brother with a net.

Micah 7:3 That they may do evil with both hands earnestly, the prince asketh, and the judge asketh for a reward; and the great man, he uttereth his mischievous desire: so they wrap it up.

Micah 7:4 The best of them is as a brier: the most upright is sharper than a thorn hedge: the **Day** of thy watchmen and thy **Visitation** cometh; now shall be their perplexity.

Micah 7:5 Trust ye not in a friend, put ye not confidence in a guide: keep the doors of thy mouth from her that lieth in thy bosom.

Micah 7:6 For the son dishonoureth the father, the daughter riseth up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies are the men of his own house.

Micah 7:7 Therefore I will look unto the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me.

Micah 7:8 Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord shall be a light unto me.

Micah 7:9 I will bear the indignation of the Lord, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, and I shall behold his righteousness.

Micah 7:10 Then she that is mine enemy shall see it, and shame shall cover her which said unto me, Where is the Lord thy God? mine eyes shall behold her: now shall she be trodden down as the mire of the streets.

Micah 7:11 In the day that thy walls are to be built, in **That Day** shall the decree be far removed.

Micah 7:12 In **That Day** also he shall come even to thee from Assyria, and from the fortified cities, and from the fortress even to the river, and from sea to sea, and from mountain to mountain.

Micah 7:13 Notwithstanding the land shall be desolate because of them that dwell therein, for the fruit of their doings.

Micah 7:14 Feed thy people with thy rod, the flock of thine heritage, which dwell solitarily in the wood, in the midst of Carmel: let them feed in Bashan and Gilead, as in the days of old.

Micah 7:15 According to the days of thy coming out of the land of Egypt will I shew unto him marvellous things.

Micah 7:16 The nations shall see and be confounded at all their might: they shall lay their hand upon their mouth, their ears shall be deaf.

Micah 7:17 They shall lick the dust like a serpent, they shall move out of their holes like worms of the earth: they shall be afraid of the Lord our God, and shall fear because of thee.

Micah 7:18 Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy.

Micah 7:19 He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.

Micah 7:20 Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.
